Abstract

Since the first electronic journals began to appear as electronic products on the Web in 1995, the number of electronic resources available on the internet has grown so rapidly that it has fundamentally changed how libraries managing and providing accesses to resources. Nowadays, libraries typically subscribe to tens of thousands of electronic resources. How to effectively manage the subscription of these licensed resources has long been and will continue to be critical for libraries at all levels. This presentation highlights how Lingnan University Library accomplish this critical mission by integrating III Millennium and a locally developed system SUMAS (Subscription Management Solution) into the workflow of managing electronic resource subscriptions.
