

## New continent or Bermuda? The consolidation of e-resources in Hong Kong Shue Yan University Library

### Abstract

Hong Kong Shue Yan University Library (Former: Hong Kong Shue Yan College Library) have developed the e-resource collection since 1999. The first two online databases in the Library were China InfoBank and Financial Times. After seven years development, the Library is subscribing over 29 online databases, 30,000 e-books and 26,000 full text e-journal titles.

There is no doubt that the huge growth of e-resources is a new continent to the users. One the other hand, the users may get lost in the confusion between different platforms, interfaces, searching methods, because of the information literacy level of the users, the searching behavior and the competition of Google etc.

This presentation will focus on the experience to improve the searching environment of e-resources in Hong Kong Shue Yan University.
